COMBINED CLUBS TENNIS COMPETITION CHRISTCHURCH

The competition began in 1977/78 under the name of Combined Clubs Tennis Competition with matches played on Sunday so as not to interfere with Saturday afternoon club tennis. Over the years many clubs have participated; Kingburn, where it all started, Redwood, Marshlands, New Brighton, St. Albans, Riccarton Domain, Yaldhurst, Sefton, Lyttelton, Old Boys Te Kura, Burnham Camp, North Beach Mt Pleasant and most recently St Martins.

The name Gallington was adopted in memory of Arthur Gallington one of Kingburn Tennis Club's original committee members. The club name being derived from Kings Church at Burnside.

Since inception, competition for the Shield has been an annual event, even when the number of clubs involved had dropped to as few as four or the 2011 earthquakes which devastated many of Christchurch's tennis courts.
